### 2025 Calderdale Ageing Well Survey – closes 16<sup>th</sup> November.

Running in conjunction with the International Day of Older People activities in October, Age Friendly Calderdale is running another Ageing Well Survey and here's how to take part. It will only take around 5 minutes to complete and includes questions about belonging and what supports social connections.

### Two Calderdale stations to benefit from Accessibility Programme

West Yorkshire Combined Authority is working with Northern Trains to make accessibility improvements to stations across the region as part of its Access for All programme. They aim to make sure customers are safe, can get the information they need and wait somewhere comfortable with the right facilities. Halifax and Hebden Bridge are two Calderdale stations earmarked for change due to start in 2027.

### Countryside Work Party volunteering

Calderdale Council organises volunteer work parties to perform various countryside management tasks working at different locations with a weekly schedule weekly so volunteers can decide which days they would like to attend. Tasks include habitat management, drainage work, footpath maintenance, tree planting, hedge laying and dry-stone walling. Mondays and Tuesdays starting at 10am through 2.30pm. ### Update: Latest on Halifax Town Centre project

The planned changes will connect Halifax Rail Station to the centre through a new town gateway at Square Chapel, and route traffic away from the town centre. At this gateway, they will create an open and welcoming public space on the approach to the Piece Hall, and a pleasant walking and cycling route into the town centre. To create all of this, they will build a new road to the east of the Hughes Corporation building and serve as the main road carrying traffic around the eastern side of Halifax.
